# Fraud Alert- Beware of SMISHING SCAMS

Scammers are sending fraudulent text messages, or "smishing," pretending to be banks, delivery services, or government agencies.

These messages try to trick you into clicking links or sharing personal information. The FBI has reported a surge in these attacks targeting both iPhone and Android users.

- **Do not click links.** Avoid clicking links in unsolicited messages.
- **Verify the source.** Contact the organization directly using official contact information.
- Report it. Forward texts to 7726 (SPAM) and report to the FTC at www.ftc.gov/complaint
